Perhaps it was simply a mistake; but if it is the Academy's normal practice I should like to enquire, before I become a member, whether there is any plan afoot for recognising in an official way that you do now have members who are inappropriately thus addressed. I am not one of those who would wish all members of the Academy to be addressed as 'Madam', and I am happy to be (from time to time) the Chairman of this or that committee. But you would I think be surprised if I addressed you as 'Madam' and it is precisely the same for me to be addressed as 'Sir'.
